**RESOLUTION NO. 8-01-7**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO ARTS AND FACILITIES COMMISSION AND/OR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE JOHN AND ANNIE GLENN MUSEUM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village desires to sell certain real property within the Village to be used as the site of the John and Annie Glenn Historic Site and Exploration Center; and

WHEREAS, a purchase agreement is required prior to the actual sale of the property; and

WHEREAS, the Village is permitted by law to sell and transfer property for other public purposes; and


WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this resolution is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:




