

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 9-02-1

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RATES AND AMOUNTS AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council, in accordance with the provisions of the law, has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding, fiscal year commencing January 1, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Muskingum County, Ohio has certified its actions thereon to the Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is outside, and what part inside, the ten mill tax limitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification be and the same are hereby accepted; and be it further resolved that:

Section 2. There be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said Village the rate of each tax necessary to be levied inside and outside the ten mill limitation as follows:


General Fund	\$78,276.00 @ tax rate of 3.10 Inside ten mill
Street Repair	\$73,393.00 @ tax rate of 3.20 Outside ten mill

And be it further resolved that:

Section 3. The Clerk of Council be, and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of said County.


