RESOLUTION NO. 9-04-4

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MUSKINGUM COUNTY NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County of Muskingum has prepared a Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord recognizes that it is susceptible to natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, a natural hazards plan is one way to plan for, and mitigate against natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires communities to develop, adopt, and implement a natural hazard mitigation plan as condition of receiving federal mitigation funds; and

WHEREAS, in order to have formal approval of the completed plan by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, each jurisdiction within the county must formally adopt the plan; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the approval deadline in a timely manner, this resolution shall be considered an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village of New Concord has participated in the development and preparation of the plan.

Section 2. The Village of New Concord has agreed to participate in the implementation of the plan, including the undertaking of mitigation activities, and the continued participation with the Core Group to monitor the implementation process.

Section 3. The Village of New Concord formally adopts the Muskingum County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan as it has been written and presented to the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Section 4. For reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




