RESOLUTION NO. 9-04-5

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A BID THROUGH THE STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER VILLAGE OFFICIAL TO PROCEED WITH THE PURCHASE OF A DEFIBRILLATOR/MONITOR THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has determined the need to purchase new defibrillator/monitor for the fire department; and

WHEREAS, Section 125 of the O.R.C. permits the village to make purchases without competitive bidding through state contracts; and

WHEREAS, as Medtronic Physio-Control Corp. is the State's vendor for defibrillator/monitors; and

WHEREAS, the immediate purchase is necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the state bid price from Medtronic Physio-Control Corp. as listed below through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program is the lowest and best bid:

2 ea. Lifepak 12 Biphasic Defibrillator/monitors \$31,811

Section 2. For the reasons stated above this resolution shall be an emergency measure and the Fire Chief is hereby authorized to make said purchase at the earliest period allowed by law.


