RESOLUTION NO. 11-13-2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE BUCKEYE WATER COMPANY FOR EXPENSES TO PLAN IMPROVEMENTS AT THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT FOR SEWER EFFLUENT REUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council deems it is necessary and proper for the Village to enter into an agreement with the Buckeye Water Company for reuse of WWTP effluent and;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into agreements for said services, and;

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is the appropriate person to enter into the agreements on behalf of the Village, and;

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this resolution is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:




Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.


