**RESOLUTION NO. 11-13-6**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT INNOVATION GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER VILLAGE OFFICIALS TO APPLY FOR AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT WITH OTHER ENTITIES TO IMPROVE AND EXPAND ARTS AND RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES IN THE COMMUNITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council deems it is necessary and proper for the village to collaborate with East Muskingum School District, Muskingum University and others to improve the efficiency of arts and recreation in the community, and;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into agreements for said improvements in order to obtain the support of the state of Ohio, and;

WHEREAS, the mayor, fiscal officer and administrator are the appropriate officials to enter into the agreements on behalf of the Village, and;


WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this resolution is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. That the mayor, fiscal officer and administrator are hereby authorized to apply for and enter into the necessary agreements for the State of Ohio Local Government Innovation Grant Program in order to obtain professional consulting services to determine the most efficient manner to improve arts and recreation opportunities in the community.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.


