

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 12-13-6

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO INCREASE THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX FROM ONE PERCENT TO ONE AND ONE HALF OF ONE PERCENT IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION OF VILLAGE SAFETY SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord is responsible for the operation of the Village safety services; and

WHEREAS, the council of the Village of New Concord first adopted a one percent (1%) general income tax in 1972, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the tax rate for the benefit of the Village of New Concord for the purposes previously stated herein; and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this Resolution is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of New Concord.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio that a majority of all members elected thereto concurring, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the amount of revenue which may be collected by the Village of New Concord by the current 1.0 percent (1.0%) municipal income tax rate will be insufficient to provide adequate funds for the operation of Village of New Concord Safety Services and that it is necessary to levy a tax increase of one half of one percent in excess of that limitation for the purpose of funding the operation of the Village of New Concord Safety Services.



It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in their formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all the law.

Section 3. For the reasons stated within the preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
