### **REPORTS**

**Solicitor:** Eickelberger reported pending legal matters to be discussed in executive session.

**Police Chief:** Chief Hayes gave the September monthly report.

- 1) Reported 173 calls for service in September.
- 2) Reported John Glenn High School Homecoming Parade was successful and without any issues.
- 3) Reported the department did not receive the School Resource Officer Grant.
- 4) Chief Hayes will be applying for a grant to fund body worn cameras. The grant will cover 90% of the projects funding.
- 5) Reported October 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 p.m. the department will be partnering with Ohio University-Zanesville/Zane State College in presenting Stranger Danger Program at Littick Hall on the OUZ/ZS Campus.

**Fire Chief:** Chief Gates gave the September monthly report.

- 1) Reported 16 fire runs and 105 EMS runs with 108 EMS patients for September.
- 2) Reported Board of Trade Christmas Parade will be December 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:30 p.m.

**Mayor:** Mayor Adams reported Trick or Treat will be October 30<sup>th</sup> from 6 to 7 p.m. and asks if residents don't wish to participate to turn off all outside lights.

- 1) Mayor Adams asked council to review 2015 council meeting schedule.

**Infrastructure/Safety:** Committees met collectively prior to council meeting.

- 1) Committee discussed Unnamed Alley Project in progress for safety reasons. Gates and Morrow to get list/map of all Village alleys without names.
- 2) Muskingum University 1<sup>st</sup> year Political Science students and Dr. Huber will draft and conduct a simple resident satisfaction survey for Village departments. Colley will speak to class about the project and its use by the Village. Colley to share survey information with Policy Committee and bring results back for review.
- 3) Committee discussed N. Friendship Drive visibility issue – Colley to contact ODOT for Safety Evaluation of Friendship Drive.
- 4) Reported dead pine tree in unopened alley between 9 & 7 Garfield Ave – Colley to contact AEP to request they remove tree as it is entangled in power lines.
- 5) Reported dead trees on Main Street in front of businesses – Colley to contact businesses and provide tree replacement list with costs for them to choose from for replacement planting after tree removal.
- 6) Committee discussed Bradford pear tree trimming issues. Colley to develop a Bradford pear tree replacement schedule for the Village.
