Police Chief: Chief Hayes gave the April monthly report.

- 1) Total calls for service for April were 70, with 15 underage consumption citations being issued.
- 2) Reported Stranger Danger event was successful.

Fire Chief: Chief Gates gave the April monthly report.

- 1) Reported 34 fire runs and 76 EMS runs with 77 EMS patients for April.
- 2) Reported that man hours is at a 50% reduction.
- 3) Reported Congressman Bill Johnson visited the department.
- 4) Reported Board of Trade Farmer's Market will be held on Mondays starting July 14th @ 4 p.m.
- 5) Reported receiving Fire Department Training Grant from the Division of State Fire Marshal in the amount of \$6,995.
