REPORTS

Solicitor: Eickelberger reported that Magistrate Court matters are proceeding well.

Police Chief: Chief Hayes gave the May monthly report.

- 1) Reported police department continues to enforce traffic around SR 83 bridge replacement and ODOT has placed temporary barricades while officers increased their patrol and continue to issue citations to combat the situation.
- 2) Chief Hayes reported officers assisted with several events in the village and thanked the officers for their hard work making the events go as easy as possible.
- 3) Reported the Speed Measuring Box has been repaired and is back in service.
- 4) Reported the police department participated in the Click-it-or-Ticket program this year with hopes of receiving a free Radar unit.
- 5) Chief Hayes met with the Safety Committee to discuss COPS Grant for a full time School Resource Officer for East Muskingum Schools.

Fire Chief: Chief Gates gave the May monthly report.

- 1) Reported 19 fire runs and 86 EMS runs with 89 EMS patients for May.
- 2) Reported number of runs has increased with a decrease in response time.
- 3) Reported the medic (3rd out) is on loan to Adamsville.
- 4) Reported Board of Trade Farmer's Market will be held on Mondays starting July 14th at 4 p.m.
- 5) Reported the need to research various runs to Beckett House that could possibly be billed.
- 6) Reported the fire department will be assisting NCAARD with Movies in the Park on June 21st, July 19th and August 23rd.

Mayor: Mayor Adams announced Celebrate New Concord will be held June 17th at 7 p.m.

- 1) Mayor Adams reported the opening of Celebrate New Concord that was held on June 3rd was attended by over 250 people and thanked Rod Lang for his participation.
- 2) Mayor Adams reported Planning Commission is scheduled to meet July 16th at 6:30 p.m.
- 3) Mayor Adams reported he is looking at dates/times to meet with township partners to discuss fire department levy contracts.

- 2) Committee reported endorsing Ordinance No. D-8-14-1 to amend the policies and rules for the New Concord Water and Sewer Department.
