ORDINANCE NO. F-11-16-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE F-3-16-1, PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Village Council may create funds and amend the permanent appropriations ordinance as necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the Fiscal Officer be able to pay current expenses of the Village for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 1. That there be appropriated funds as follows:

Fund	Current Appropriations	Additional Amount	Total Appropriations
E1 Water Fund Expenses	\$576,343	\$20,000	\$596,343
E2 Sewer Fund Expenses	\$562,515	\$10,000	\$572,515

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble above, which is made a part hereof, this Ordinance is hereby declared to an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from its passage.


