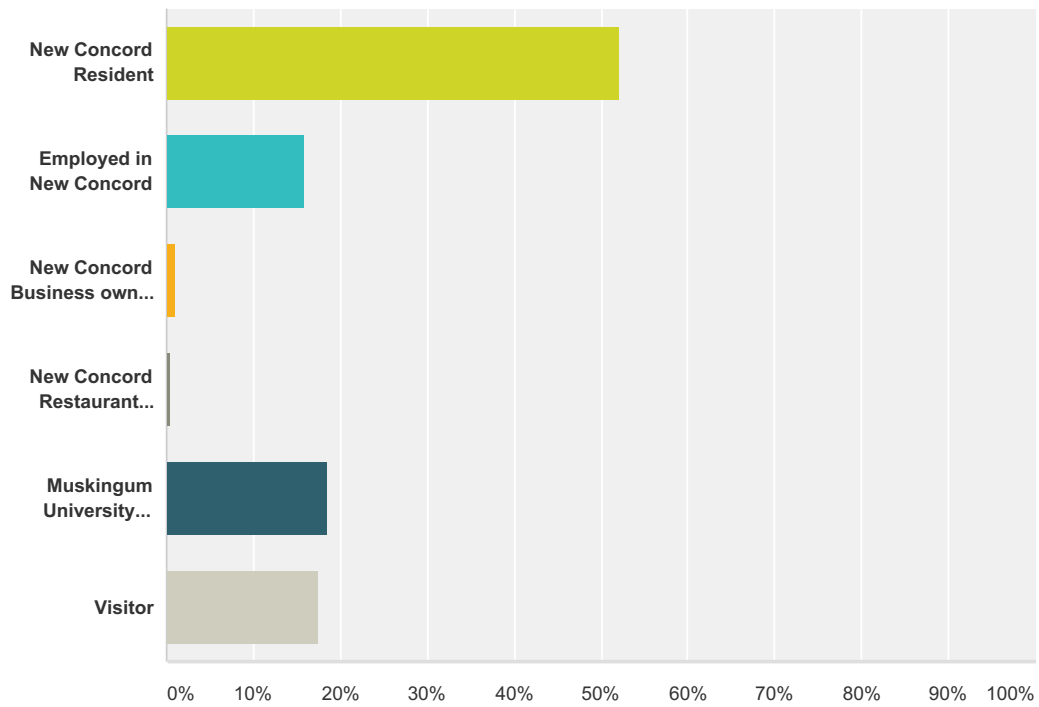

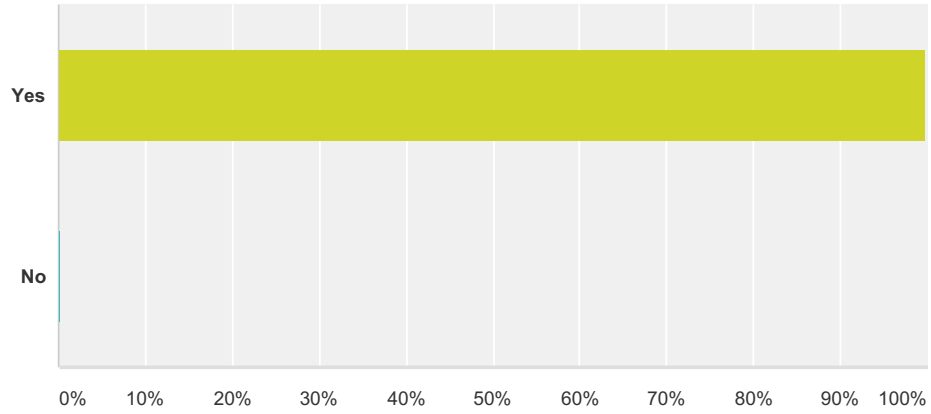

### Q2 Are you aware of the Smokin' Burrito Joe's food truck on Main Street in New Concord?

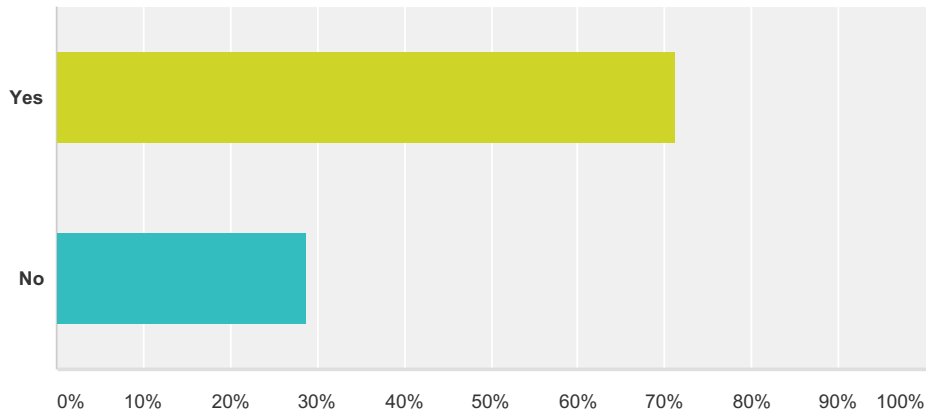

### Q3 Have you purchased food or products from this business?

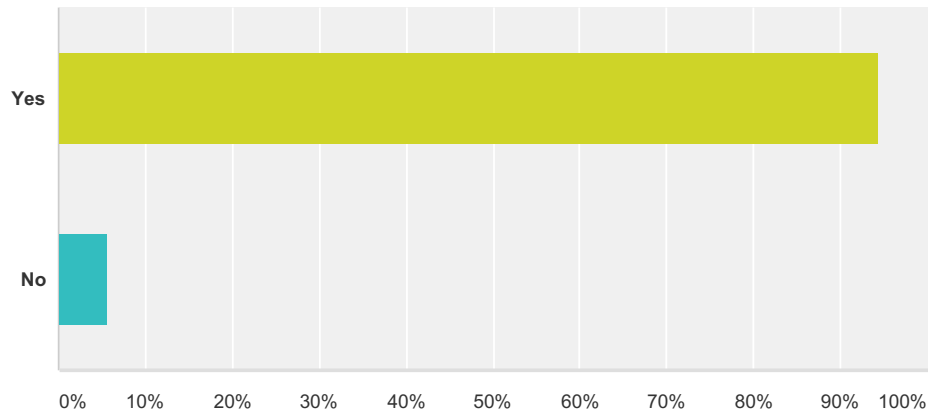

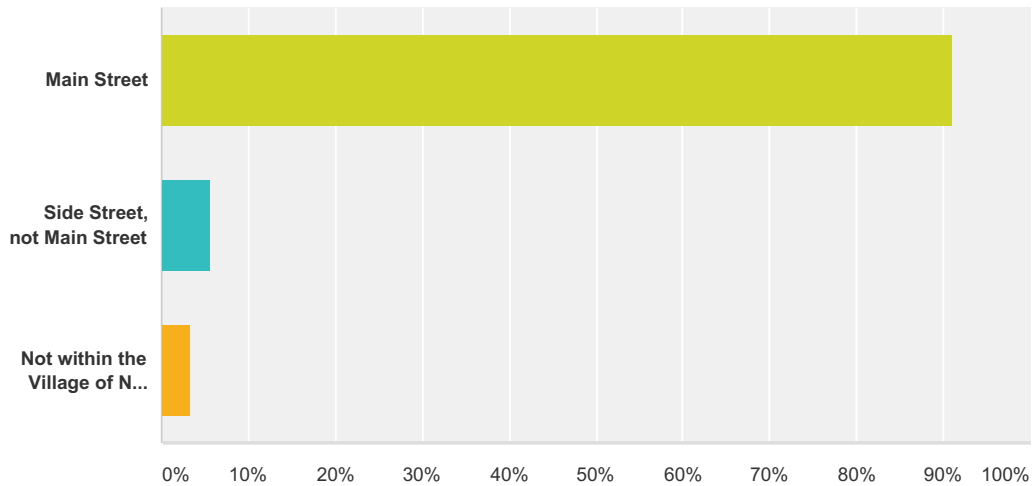
