RESOLUTION NO. 1-14-1

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD THE QUESTION OF A ONE HALF OF ONE PERCENT MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX INCREASE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION OF VILLAGE SAFETY SERVICES AND DIRECTING THE MUSKINGUM COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO PLACE UPON THE BALLOT OF THE MAY 6, 2014 PRIMARY ELECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO THE QUESTION OF RAISING THE RATE OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX FROM ONE PERCENT TO ONE AND ONE HALF PERCENT, FIRST READING

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord by Resolution 12-13-5 has determined that it is necessary to submit to the electors of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio, the question of increasing the municipal income tax rate from one percent (1%) to one and one half of one percent (1.5%) in order to fund the operation of the Village of New Concord Safety Services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Council of the Village of New Concord to request and instruct the Board of Elections of Muskingum County to submit to the electors of the Village of New Concord the question of increasing the income tax rate from one percent (1%) to one and one half of one percent (1.5%) at the primary election to be held on May 6, 2014, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village that this resolution be declared an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The council of the Village of New Concord hereby requests and instructs the Board of Elections of Muskingum County to submit to the electors the following question of increasing the income tax rate from one percent (1%) to one and one half of one percent (1.5%) for the Village of New Concord at the primary election to be held on May 6, 2014;

PROPOSED MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX INCREASE

A majority affirmative vote of the electors is necessary for passage.

Shall Ordinance I-1-14-1 to increase the Village of New Concord municipal income tax rate by one half of one percent (.5%) from the current one percent (1.0%) to one and one half of

one percent (1.5%) for the purpose of funding the operation of the Village of New Concord Safety Services be passed and approved ?

Section 2. Said increase shall take effect and the collection of said taxes shall commence beginning on January 1, 2015, in compliance with Ordinance I-2-02-1, Ordinance I-12-82-1, Resolution 12-83-1, Ordinance I-1-14-1 and amendments thereto approved by the council of the Village of New Concord if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 3. That the Clerk/Fiscal Officer of Council of the Village of New Concord is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Muskingum County, Ohio and the Board of Elections of Muskingum County ninety (90) days prior to said election

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of Council of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution shall be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately.
