Auxiliary Officer Position

It is the goal of the New Concord Police Department (NCPD) to protect and serve the residents, businesses and visitors of the Village. Every NCPD officer must be committed to reaching this goal. In order to supplement and assist the full-time and part-time officers employed by the Village, the NCPD has developed an Auxiliary Officer program. Auxiliary officers are an asset to the Village and have the potential to move into full or part-time openings dependent on performance and needs to the department.

Qualifications and Expectations

Auxiliary officers will attend and pass state mandated firearms recertification. Auxiliary officers will obtain the minimum continuing education as mandated by the State of Ohio. Auxiliary officers will be held accountable to the same standards as other full time and part time officers and will abide by all rules and regulations set forth by the current policy manual.

The Village of New Concord auxiliary officers will volunteer a minimum of 96 hours per year on NCPD activities, shifts, ride-alongs and community events. Each auxiliary officer will be required to volunteer 8 hours of time to the Village of New Concord per month.

Auxiliary officers will be required to attend a minimum of two (2) meetings per year. All auxiliary officers will attend the Annual Christmas Parade, the Police Department Open House and attend a minimum of 5 additional Village functions.
