

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. F-11-18-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE F-3-18-1 IN ORDER TO REDUCE FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the certified balances have been received from the Muskingum County Budget Commission enabling this council to enact a permanent appropriations ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the Fiscal Officer be able to pay current expenses of the Village for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that, to provide for the expenditures of the Village of New Concord during the year ending December 31, 2018, the following amounts be set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 1. That there be appropriated funds as follows:

Fund	Current Appropriations	Decrease Amount	Total Appropriations
2101 MVL Permissive Tax Fund	\$ 9,000	- 6,000	\$ 3,000
2402 Garland Hotel TIF Fund	\$ 216,000	- 50,000	\$ 166,000
4902 Water System Improvement	\$ 73,000	- 30,000	\$ 43,000

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
